

ALUMNI ASSOCIATION ENDOWMENT FUND – CHEE PHUI HUNG BURSARY NUS

The Alumni Association Endowment Fund was mooted by the Alumni Association Management Committee in memory of the late Dr Chee Phui Hung, our “inimitable “Agong”, one of the great pioneering members and an icon that the Alumni Association has ever had. Dr Chee has over his last 50 years or more, given his unstinting and unfaltering support to the Alumni Association and helped it grow in strength and stature. The establishment of the “Alumni Association Endowment Fund” is to help needy students at the NUS. As of 25 Jan 2011, an amount of \$347,696.43 has been raised. The donation will be matched one and a half times by the government. Disbursements from the interests accrued will be awarded to the 3 disciplines each; medical, dental and pharmacy students. The selection criteria will be based on the guidelines set down by the University panel. The family of the late Dr Chee would like to award the Bursaries to candidates who possess additional qualities like leadership, sportsmanship, care for the community and a commitment to the alumni relations after graduation, although these qualities may not be the main deciding factors.

The Chee family has donated 7 sets of “Fok Lok Sou” figurines to raise some fund for the bursary. The photographs of the figurines can be viewed from the web page: www.medicalalumni.org.sg The Alumni Management Committee will be organising a silent bidding process for the 7 sets of “Fok Lok Sou”. Members are invited to submit their bids to the Alumni office. Dr PH Chee had a passion for antiques and these figurines were collected during his life time – at least more than 50 years. The fund raised from the bidding will be donated to the “Alumni Association Endowment Fund – Chee Phui Hung Bursary NUS”. The figurines will be open for viewing at the Alumni Association from *March 21st to 25th*. The bidding will close at 12 noon on March 29th 2011.

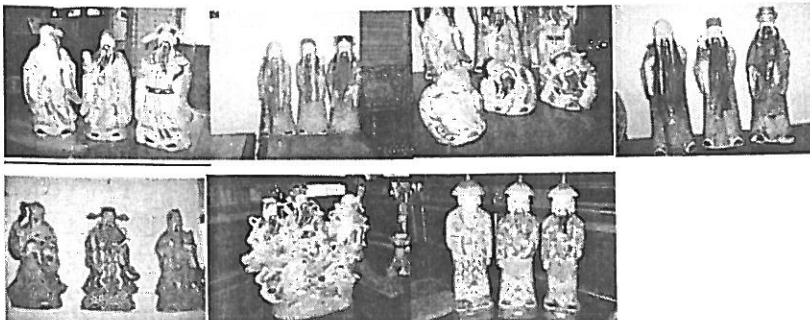
